**Goshen Motorsports and Joshua Goshen Make Speed
Truck Debut**

Goshen Motorsports made its second entry into the ASA Speed Truck Challenge in front of a packed house at the ½ mile Toyota Raceway in Irwindale, California on Saturday, October 25. Their young 14 year old driver, Joshua Goshen, was making his second start in oval racing. This was the season finale for the 2008 season and the younger of the two Goshen brothers was driving to gain experience in preparation for the full 2009 season.

There was a Friday evening practice and qualifying started Saturday afternoon at 4:00 P.M. With little experience compared to the rest of the drivers, Joshua qualified 12th out of the seventeen cars in the field. During qualifying he did get a little close to the wall coming out of Turn 2 and left his first mark on the Toyota Raceway.

The pre-race event was the autograph session, with Joshua Goshen signing hero cards while standing beside his truck in Goshen Motorsports colors and the Team sponsor's Global Tracking Communications, Inc., Otto Environmental Systems, Inc., Passion 4 Life, Merv Griffin Entertainment, Geneva Companies and Gatorz Precision Eyewear names clearly visible. The main event started at 7:30 P.M. with the 100 lap featured race. As the starter waived the green flag, Goshen was able to hold his position taking the high line around the track. After several laps, Joshua began moving up and was running as high as 9th position 25 laps into the race. Unfortunately, a slight encounter with the wall knocked the front end out of alignment and Goshen faded back to 12th as the race ended.

After the race Goshen was quoted as saying "it was a lot of fun and the crew gave me a good truck. I was unable to race most of this year because the Formula TR Series was cancelled in March, so I was happy to get back into racing. I am looking forward to running all of next year."
